The Irvington PTSA is delighted to once again offer an ACT preparation course this Spring. The ACT includes multiple-choice tests that cover four skill areas: English, Mathematics, Reading and Science. It also includes an optional Writing test that measures skills in planning and writing a short essay. It is often taken by juniors in addition to, or in lieu of, the SAT test.

This ACT course will prepare interested students for the **April 9, 2016 test date**. All sections of the ACT test, including Writing, will be covered in the course. It will be taught in eight 2 hour sessions at Irvington High School; the 7th session of the course will consist of a four hour mock ACT given to students to prepare them for the testing conditions.

David Hutt, founder of “ACT Alternative” will once again be teaching this class. David has 25 years of test preparation and teaching experience. He received his Masters of Education from Columbia University Teachers College and was a counselor at Bronx High School of Science for 10 years.
